Regional Measure 3/is/a/bad deal: You pay higher tolls while congestion worsens. Higher trucking costs make shopping more expensive.	127	19
Regional Measure 3 does not provide "a comprehensive <u>long-term</u> solution to reduce traffic, improve travel times and bring our public transportation system into the 21st century."	13	24
