Argument Against Measure (re: manufacturing)
Vote NO on!
Allowing manufacture of marijuana concentrates (hash, dab, wax), extracts, and edibles in HMB is a bad (6) idea for our family-oriented town. The culture of use that is associated with these extremely potent 33 extracts is at odds with our small town values and our current priorities of families, children and 50 community.
Dr. Rav Ivker, a respected medical marijuana advocate, asserts that concentrates should be illegal, 65 stating "The only thing they're good for is getting really high. But they're high risk, and there's really no 74 benefit from them." He points out that daily use of these concentrates can lead to addiction and mental 102 illness in certain vulnerable people – especially adolescents.
Many of these extracts are processed into edibles appealing to children and teens, such as candy, 125 cookies, and brownies, which are not readily identifiable as extremely potent drugs. As a result, in 141 California, the number of calls to poison control centers involving people 19 and younger who were 157 exposed to marijuana has steadily risen from 347 in 2015 to 588 in 2017!
California as well as in Colorado, Washington and Oregon has also experienced a steep increase in 187 emergency room visits for marijuana related problems experienced by both children and adults.
Do we really want our town to become known as a source of products – bearing a "made in HMB" 219 label - that are associated with such health risks? How will this affect the reputation of our town as a place known for family oriented activities and recreational sports? 247
Religious leaders, the school community and its leaders, many in the Latino community and many other 203 residents have expressed their opposition to all commercial marijuana activities in HMB at many 277 meetings! Join with us and vote NO on 286
