<u>Jefferson Union High School District \$58 Parcel Tax: Argument Against Measure</u>

With this latest "temporary" parcel tax, the Jefferson Union High School District claims they need a tax increase because they are "devoted to providing quality public deducation...".

The district failed to get voter approval in the last \$85 parcel tax ballot measure, and 16 now they want to try again for a more modest tax of \$58 per year for 10 years for most 20 homeowners.

Have they earned this tax increase that will cost you over \$580 over the next 10 years \(\frac{1}{2}\) (on top of the taxes you are already paying)?

Let's look at the student performances in two key subjects:\@

- 2016-17 students not meeting English literacy standards: 53.6% [¬]
- 2016-17 <u>students not meeting</u> Math literacy standards: 63.7%

The District, which spends \$11,269 per student, per year, rewarded parents and taxpayers by increasing the number of students who failed to meet English & Math standards!
