15 Vote Yes on Measure W to repair 60-year-old classrooms, expand and modernize science labs and help prepare local students for success in college and the 21st-century competitive job market. 1.5

13 Sequoia Union High School District proudly serves nearly 9,000 students in our bay area  
15 communities. However, 3 of our main high schools were built in the 1950s, and the original  
18 Sequoia campus in the 1920s. Since then, building, safety and education standards have  
16 changed. Some of the schools still contain asbestos and lead pipes, while others need to be  
4 retrofitted for earthquake safety.

13 Several classrooms are so old they have small classrooms, inadequate ventilation, use radiator  
15 heaters, and have just one or two electrical outlets, not nearly enough to support the learning  
16 technology our kids need to excel now and in the future. As the temperature rises, classrooms  
16 get too hot to teach in, and ventilation systems are not sufficient to ensure healthy, smoke free  
5 air for students and educators.

13 Measure W provides locally controlled funding to repair and update our high schools, ensuring  
13 all students have equal access to safe and up-to-date learning environments. In addition,  
13 maintaining excellent local high schools keeps our communities and property values strong.
