Sample Ballot and Official Voter Information Pamphlet

Commencing September 26, 2024, the **Sample Ballot and Official Voter Information Pamphlet** will be mailed to every registered voter in San Mateo County and available online at *smcvote.gov*. The pamphlet provides important information on the **November 5, 2024** Presidential General Election and the many voting options available to voters.

"Where's My Ballot?" enables voters to track their ballots from the moment they are mailed by our office to the time they are counted. Sign up at *smcvote.gov* to receive text alerts, email notifications and updates.

Voting by Mail is Safe, Easy and Convenient. All registered voters will be mailed an **Official Ballot** with a postage-paid return envelope, beginning October 7, 2024. Return your ballot in the mail, to a Ballot Drop Box or at any Vote Center.



Ballot Drop Box Locations. There will be **63 Ballot Drop Boxes** located throughout the County. View locations at *smcvote.gov*.



Vote Centers. There will be **49 Vote Centers** located throughout the County for in-person voting and voter services. For Vote Center locations and hours, visit *smcvote.gov*.
